This beautifully constructed Mosque, completed in 2006, was built to serve the growing Muslim community in Central Connecticut. Imam Ali Antar is Professor and Chair of the Physics and Earth Sciences Department at Central Connecticut State University and Coordinator of its Middle Eastern Studies Program. He is president of the Islamic Association of Greater Hartford and former member of Hartford Seminary's Board of Trustees.

The tour is part of an ongoing series designed to help us learn about the many religious communities which are a part of our Connecticut culture. Each visit includes a tour, a presentation on basic beliefs and practices, and time for questions and conversation. Light refreshment is also offered. Upcoming programs in this series include a visit to the Hartford KTC Tara & Shedrup Tibetan Buddhist Center and in Southington, the Sikh Gurdwara Guru Nanak Darbar.

## DIRECTIONS

**From South:** Take I-91 N to Rt. 15 N into Berlin. After the Berlin town line, count 5 traffic lights. You will then see a sign for a miniature golf, batting cages, and Subway Store.\*

**From North:** Take I-91 S to 15 S (Exit 28). Drive about 9 miles on Rt. 15 through Wethersfield, Newington and into Berlin. After the Rt. 9 overpass, count 4 traffic lights. After the 4th light, make a U-turn. Follow the directions below when you see the sign for the batting cages and Subway.\*

**From West or East:** Take I-84, at exit 39A, to Rt. 9 S. Take exit 21 off Rt. 9. At the traffic light of the off-ramp, take a left on to Rt. 15 S. At the 3rd traffic light make a U-turn. Follow the directions below when you see the sign for the batting cages and Subway.\*

\*The Mosque is at the corner of Wilbur Cross Highway (Berlin Turnpike) and Bishop's Curve (take a right at the corner). The entrance is the first driveway on the left.
