

CCIU Executive Director Position

The Board of Directors of the Connecticut Council for Interreligious Understanding Inc. (CCIU) seeks to hire a part time Executive Director with the skills and experience necessary for the leadership and administrative coordination of a non-profit interfaith organization. CCIU is dedicated to educating adults and young people about the worlds religions, the values they share in common, and their differences, in order to overcome religious illiteracy, build understanding and acceptance, and break down prejudice and intolerance.

The successful candidate will demonstrate a working philosophy consistent with, and a passion for CCIU's stated commitment to religious and cultural pluralism.

Candidates must possess a Bachelors degree, preferably a Masters, demonstrated interest and experience in interfaith work; experience in leading groups of volunteers; successful fundraising and grant writing experience; strong skills in networking and community building, and active participation in a religious/faith group.

The position will be an Independent Contractor with the annual contract of \$40,000.

There are no benefits, other than 2 weeks of paid vacation. This part time position requires an average of 25 hours of work per week, some of which may be in evenings and weekends with an overall flexible schedule.
